<p><u>Anti-Depressant Agents</u> Paroxetine CR, Pexeva, Trintellix, Viibryd</p>	<p>Any generic SSRI or SNRI</p> <p>*MUST try 2 different agents before moving to 'Trigger Drugs'</p>
<p><u>Anti-Hypertensive Agents</u> Atacand (candesartan), Atacand HCT (candesartan/HCTZ), Edarbi, Tribenzor (amlodipine/olmesartan/HCTZ), Twynsta (telmisartan/amlodipine)</p>	<p>Any generic ACEI or ARB Any generic thiazide</p> <p>*MUST try 3 different agents before moving to 'Trigger Drugs'</p>
<p><u>Dementia/ Alzheimer's</u> Razadyne (galantamine), Razadyne ER (galantamine ER), Exelon (rivastigmine), Exelon patch, Namzaric, Aricept ER, Namenda XR</p>	<p>Generic Aricept (donepezil) or Namenda (memantine)</p>
<p><u>Cholesterol Medications</u> Fluvastatin, Lescol, Livalo, Vytorin (ezetimibe/simvastatin)</p>	<p>Any generic statin, generic Zetia (ezetimibe)</p> <p>*MUST try 2 different agents before moving to 'Trigger Drugs'</p>
<p><u>Gout</u> Uloric</p>	<p>Allopurinol</p>
<p><u>Hypnotics</u> Belsomra, Edluar, Intermezzo (zolpidem 1.75mg, 3.5mg), Rozerem, Zolpidem ER, Zolpimist</p>	<p>Amitriptyline, Eszopiclone, Temazepam, Trazadone, Zaleplon, Zolpidem</p> <p>*MUST try 2 different agents before moving to 'Trigger Drugs'</p>
<p><u>Migraine Agents</u> Almotriptan, Frova, Frovatriptan, sumatriptan injection, sumatriptan intranasal, zolmitriptan intranasal</p>	<p>Oral Sumatriptan, Eletriptan, Naratriptan, Rizatriptan, Zolmitriptan</p> <p>*MUST try 2 different agents before moving to 'Trigger Drugs'</p>
<p><u>Osteoporosis</u> Actonel (risedronate), Atelvia</p>	<p>Alendronate, Ibandronate</p>



<p><u>Overactive Bladder</u> Enablex (darifenacin), Myrbetriq, Toviaz, Vesicare</p>	<p>Oxybutynin, generic Detrol (tolterodine)</p>
<p><u>PUD/GERD</u> Dexilant</p>	<p>Any generic H2 antagonist or PPI</p> <p>*MUST try 2 different agents before moving to 'Trigger Drugs'</p>
<p><u>Topical Acne Medications</u> Acanya, Aczone, Azelex, Benzaclin, Epiduo Forte, Evoclin, Fabior, Finacea, Inova, Onexton, Renova, tazarotene 0.1% cream, Tazorac, Veltin, Ziana</p>	<p>Clindamycin: 1% lotion, 1% solution, 1% gel (not 75mL), 2% cream</p> <p>Clindamycin/benzoyl peroxide: 1.2-5% gel</p> <p>Generic Epiduo (adapalene/benzoyl peroxide 0.1- 2.5%)</p> <p>Erythromycin: 2% gel, 2% solution Erythromycin/benzoyl peroxide: 3-5% gel</p> <p>Tretinoin: any generic (not micro or 0.04%)</p> <p>*MUST try 3 different agents before moving to 'Trigger Drugs'</p>
